

Report from the Life Member Affinity Group (LMAG)

The LMAG Committee has held two virtual meetings in which the main items for discussion were the status of various IEEE Milestone applications. The postponement of the unveiling of the plaque awarded for **Active Shielding of Superconducting Magnets**, originally scheduled for May 1st 2020, has delayed the event further because of lockdown, and the present inability of the Siemens management representatives to travel from Germany. It is hoped that the unveiling will be held later this year.

Currently, there are three other applications being considered by the IEEE History Committee, and three under consideration by the LMAG Committee.

The Committee has been active in the revival of the King's College London IEEE Student Branch, sponsoring two events so far. Any members interested in giving a talk to Student Branches are invited to contact the Committee.
