- **Procedures for Financial Support Requests and Approvals**
 - This to be done through a short case with costings and justifications
- **Chapter Leadership**
 - Succession planning and Terms of Office
- **L31 submissions**
 - Ease and automate the process of L31 submissions
- **Re-initiate more face-to-face activities**
 - Keeping in mind the new norms we are now set to operate in

- Creating two areas from within Region 8:

- We are Co-sponsors for RTSI'2022 in France and will host RTSI'2022
- Region 8 will only get 5% from the conference profits
