- Registration based on joint membership being explored
 - Reduction of % of both membership fees (15% suggested) or
 - Reduction in the registration fee for IET members who are also longstanding IEEE members
- Would that be enough to achieve our objective of retaining members through the university to industry transition (especially given employer's reluctance to pay more than one professional subscription)?
- Initial reaction to subscription reduction from IEEE President cautious.

Plan of activities for 2023-24

- Izzet will continue dialogue with Saifur Rahman and IEEE HQ
- Rod will maintain contact with Ed Almond
- We will try to reach a mutually acceptable solution over the next few weeks
- If that fails we will re-commence the discussions with other PEI's such as the IOP and IRSE re. them offering registration to IEEE UK & I Section as a paid service.
