- Each supervisor can nominate two PhD students maximum during this selection period.
- Nomination deadline is 31 May 2023. The outcome will be announced by 31 August 2024.

PRIZES

Each award consists of a certificate from the IEEE UK&I Chapter, £400 for 1st Prize; and £300 for 2nd Prize; including cash and/or IEEE membership fees. The prizes will be awarded to the winners during the IEEE UK&I Chapter Annual Meeting and announced publicly on the IEEE UK&I Chapter website.
